Please pay close attention to the exact number and title of the mandatory courses. Only those titles and number sections listed below will be accepted.

- **IS-100.a INTRODUCTION TO INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM , I-100**
- **IS-200.a ICS FOR SINGLE RESOURCES AND INITIAL ACTION INCIDENTS**
- **IS-700.a NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS (NIMS), AN INTRODUCTION**

Upon completion of each course you will take an exam. After successfully passing the exams you will receive an email advising that you have passed. In this email will be a link to a certificate. You will need to do the following:

1. **Print out the email you receive for each course**
2. **Print out the certificate you receive for each course**
3. **Staple each email and certificate together and bring to Charvetta Ford McGriff at Medic**
4. **Make a file for yourself at home**
5. **Place a copy of the email and certificate in file.**
