Objective(s) 1. Provide Fire, EMS and Law Enforcement protection to fans and attendees. 2. Establish Unified Command of all parties responsible for attendee safety during event. 3. Maintain communication with all response teams and offsite communication centers. 4. Provide traffic control for the area around the stadium 5. Monitor MSA equipment (SafeSites) and radiation equipment around stadium before, during and after the event. 6. Monitor crowd activity via the Mobile Operation Center (MOC) around stadium before, during and after the event. 7. Setup and staff the MOC at its fixed location for the event.			
Operational Period Command Emphasis <p>EVENT SUMMARY: This event is a regular season football game between the Carolina Panthers and the Green Bay Packers. Gates open by 11:00 and the game begins at 13:00.</p> <p>WEATHER: Partly sunny, with a high near 57. Calm SSW 10mph wind. Humidity 60%.</p> <p>SAFETY: Water will be provided at the Mobile Operations Center (MOC) for all personnel working the event. All personnel should wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for the weather and incident specific response.</p> <p>LOCATION CHANGE: The Mobile Operations Center (MOC) has been relocated this season to the corner of West 1st Street and South Mint Street. Access to this intersection MUST be made from South Church Street. All apparatus are to park along the right curb lane along West 1st Street approaching South Mint Street. The order of apparatus along the street will be the following: MOC, Haz-Mat, Tanker followed by CFD staff vehicles. Do not block any access to driveways or parking decks along West 1st Street. West 1st Street will remain open to vehicular traffic during this time so please use caution when parking apparatus. Contact BC Hartsell or EM Coordinator M. Tobin after parking to verify correct location and direction of travel.</p> <p>WATER BARRICADES: After the briefing is complete, ATV 1 will work with ATV 2 and Tanker 22 to assist CMPD in filling of "Water Barricades" at the following locations:</p> <p>*West 1st Street & South Mint Street *MLK & Graham Street *West Stonewall & South Church Street *Morehead & South Mint Street</p> <p>This will be conducted as soon as Tanker 22 arrives on-site approximately 0930 hours. After completing the assignment, Tanker 22 will reposition at the designated location along West 1st Street.</p> <p>RESOURCE SUMMARY:</p> <p>Mobile Operations Center (MOC): Stage on West 1st Street at South Mint Street, along the right curb lane. Access must be made from South Church Street. ETA 09:00.</p> <p>Haz-Mat Unit: Stage behind the MOC on West 1st Street and South Mint Street, along the right curb lane. Access must be made from South Church Street. ETA 09:30.</p> <p>CFD Tanker (T-22): Stage behind the Haz-Mat Company on West 1st Street and South Mint Street, along the right curb lane. Access must be made from South Church Street. Park behind the driveway to the parking deck. ETA 09:30.</p>			
General Situational Awareness <p>Gates open by 11:00, with the game beginning at 13:00. Stadium policies, plans, and procedures are in effect as a regular season game and CMPD will have a full traffic control deployment.</p> <p>NFL Security will be conducting a security audit throughout the day. Please be mindful as you operate in and around the stadium area.</p> <p>Be aware of surroundings at all times. Keep all personnel well hydrated, and wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for all calls. Be aware of slip, trip and fall hazards when working around staging areas. Wear appropriate gear for weather conditions. Report any and all injuries to MOC Command as soon as possible.</p> <p>Given recent national events, be especially mindful to promptly report any unusual or suspicious activities - remember, "See Something, Say Something."</p>
