Provide public safety and security for attendees to include crime control, fire protection and increased levels of medical services. 4. Coordinate with all outside resources needed to provide emergency services. 5. Fire Prevention inspection of tents and/or cooking areas for the Taste of Charlotte Festival. 6. Maintain event documentation in WebEOC. 7. Monitor crowds and attendee behavior. 8. Maintain entrance and egress routes within event footprint. 9. Provide base of operations for real world emergencies and lost persons (Alarm or HQ). 10. Facilitate communications initiatives/support from both the (Alarm or HQ) and the Mobile Command Post (MCP).			
<b>Operational Period Command Emphasis</b> <p>EVENT SUMMARY: Taste of Charlotte will consist of scheduled events beginning on Friday, June 7 through Sunday, June 9. Major planned events will take place on Tryon St. between Stonewall St. and 5th. St. The expected attendance is 40,000 people.</p> <p>LOCATION: Taste of Charlotte will be held on Tryon St. between Stonewall St. and 5th st. Two stages will also be located within the event footprint. The Community Stage will be located at the intersection of Levine Ave. and Tryon St. The Uber Eats Main Stage will be located at the intersection of Trade St. and Tryon St.</p> <p>The primary location for all command and support staff for CMPD, CFD, Emergency Management and MEDIC will be located at Charlotte Fire Department Alarm located within Charlotte Fire Department Station 1, 221 N. Myers St. Charlotte, NC 28202. CFD Alarm will be open the following hours:</p> <p>Friday, June 7, 2019: 10:30 to 23:30          Saturday, June 8, 2019: 10:30 to 23:30          Sunday, June 9, 2019: 10:30 to 18:30</p> <p>All event staff should review standard operating guidelines and follow all that apply to this event.</p> <p>Be sure to use all appropriate PPE per situation and per weather conditions.</p> <p>Remember to stay hydrated through your shift. Water will be available on site.</p> <p>The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) located at the Charlotte Police and Fire Training Academy (1770 Shopton Road, Charlotte, North Carolina 28217) is staged as a back-up location and ready for activation should it become necessary.</p> <p>POTENTIAL HIGH PROFILE IMPACTS: The following high profile, may result unforeseen activity within/around the event footprint:</p> <p>1. Charlotte Knights will play at home on Friday- Start time-19:04, Saturday-Start time-19:04 and Sunday-Start time-14:05. The Knights will have fire works on Friday, June 7 and Saturday, June 8.          2. There are no known confirmed threats towards the event at this time.</p>			
<b>General Situational Awareness (Weather, General Safety Message)</b>			

**WEATHER:**

Friday, June 7th: (DAY) A 30 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms after noon. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 84. (NIGHT) Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly after 21:00. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 69. Chance of precipitation is 60 percent.

Saturday, June 8th: (DAY) Showers and thunderstorms likely, mainly after 10:00. Cloudy, with a high near 79. Chance of precipitation is 70 percent. (NIGHT) Shower likely and possibly a thunderstorm. Cloudy, with a low around 69. Chance of precipitation is 60 percent.

Sunday, June 9th: (DAY) A 50 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 80. (NIGHT) Showers and thunderstorms likely. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 69. Chance of precipitation is 60 percent.

A Decision Support Services (DSS) is in place for Taster of Charlotte beginning Friday, June 7th at 09:00 a.m. and ending on Sunday, June 9th at 12:00 a.m. Charlotte-Mecklenburg Emergency Management (CMEMO), Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department (CMPD), and MEDIC will be alerted if there is a threat of inclement weather within a 15 mile radius of the event footprint in addition to receiving daily, one-page briefings by e-mail at 0700. If the threat of weather becomes particularly bad and closer monitoring is needed, additional briefings may be sent via e-mail throughout the day as well.

The Emergency Management Planner on shift will be responsible for reviewing the daily briefing and briefing Incident Command with any concerns and monitoring weather hazards.

**SAFETY:** All personnel should keep well hydrated and wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for the weather and incident specific response. Be aware of surroundings at all times. Be aware of slip, trip and fall hazards when working around staging areas.

Due to the high profile nature of these events, be mindful to promptly report any unusual or suspicious activities - remember, "See Something, Say Something."

**SHELTERING:** Should weather or other conditions warrant the need for an evacuation or overnight sheltering operation, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Emergency Management will facilitate all efforts associated with sheltering. ## **Charlotte Fire Department Severe Weather Plan**

### **Taste of Charlotte Festival (June 7, 8, and 9)**

History has shown that severe weather can, and has, caused havoc during special events. Planning, early warning, and the correct action minimize potential injuries to event attendees. The following procedure will be implemented when there is a high degree of certainty that some form of severe weather is about to impact the event site:

- An Emergency Management representative will be responsible for monitoring the weather during Taste of Charlotte. This will be done by monitoring the weather radio located in the Mobile Operations Center (MOC) and staying in regular contact with the National Weather Service (NWS) – Greenville/Spartanburg through a pre-arranged decision support system (DSS) alert protocol. The Emergency Management representative keeps Unified Command apprised of any adverse weather approaching the event site.
- An Emergency Management representative will ensure that Emergency Evacuation Shelter signage are placed in strategic locations as to inform event attendees of the locations of the nearest shelters and/or physical representation by staffing, available to direct attendees.
- Shelter locations for Taste of Charlotte inclement weather are as follows:
  - o NASCAR Hall of Fame parking garage (behind Buffalo Wild Wings) at 400 East Martin Luther King Boulevard.
  - o Parking garage at 230 South Tryon Street.

### **Adverse Weather Procedures**

1. An Emergency Management representative will notify Unified Command of the type of severe weather, the expected time of arrival and the estimated duration of the weather event.
2. Unified Command will notify event staff representatives to deploy Taste of Charlotte vendor managers to prepare to make an Emergency Action Message (EAM).
3. Unified Command will notify Charlotte Fire Department Alarm (911) to dispatch four (4) engine companies to the following locations:
  - a. South Tryon Street and Stonewall Street (facing North)
  - b. Martin Luther King Boulevard and Church Street (facing East)



c. North Tryon Street and Trade Street (facing South)

d. Brevard Street at 3rd Street (facing South)

4. Companies will switch over to the Unified Command assigned Fire/EMS/HazMat channel and wait to receive further directions from Unified Command or their designee.

5. The Fire/EMS Branch Director will notify all event teams and direct them to one of the two pre-designated shelters (230 South Tryon Street parking garage), 400 E. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard – NASCAR Hall of Fame parking garage) to stand-by during the storm and treat injuries as needed.

6. CMPD will notify their officers of incoming weather and assign at least one officer to each shelter location.

### **Evacuation Procedures**

1. At the direction of Unified Command, Taste of Charlotte Coordinators will notify vendor managers to stop activities and make the required Emergency Alert Message (EAM).

2. Unified Command, or their designee, will direct the engine companies to follow the below procedure:

a. Turn on outside speakers to max volume and switch to designated channel.

b. Sound their siren for two (2) minutes.

c. After the sirens are off, CFD Alarm will broadcast the inclement weather message over the designated channel. The message will be relayed twice.

d. After the message is broadcast for the second time, companies will again sound their sirens for two (2) minutes.

e. After the sirens are off, alarm will again broadcast the inclement weather message over the designated channel two (2) more times.

### **All Clear Notification**

- After consulting with an Emergency Management representative, CFD, CMPD, Taste of Charlotte vendor managers and Unified Command will give the all clear notification indicating that the weather threat has dissipated.

- Taste of Charlotte vendor managers make notifications of the all clear and the subsequent notification to begin activities.

- CFD Alarm will broadcast the all clear over truck radio systems.



- Fire/EMS teams assigned to Taste of Charlotte will return to their designated areas.
