Re: Atrium Health University City as destination during COVID-19 Pandemic

Atrium Health has now established that AH-University City will no longer be keeping inpatients COVID-19 positive at that facility (same as AH-Mercy) – what this means for us...

- Patients with a known lab test positive for COVID-19 should **NOT** be transported to AH-University City
- Patients who have a positive EIDS field screen only **CAN** be transported to AH-University City
- When providing radio report ensure that it is clear that if an EIDS field screen positive patient is being transported there that the positive refers to the field screen and not a lab confirmed positive patient
- If you are diverted away from AH-University City for a patient with only a positive field screen; divert, record the destination reason as diversion, and forward the transport number to me
- Destination decisions are unchanged for patients who are field screen negative &/or lab tested COVID-19 negative
