Mecklenburg County Park and Recreation will be offering free remote learning opportunities for Mecklenburg County/Library/Medic Employees. Five locations throughout the county have limited vacancies. These locations will offer small group focused learning environments, for students in Kindergarten through 5th grade, where students will complete their academic work during the school day. Enrichment activities will be offered outside of the school day. All CDC and NCDHHS guidelines regarding COVID-19 will be strictly followed. FAQS

1. Who is eligible to participate?
 - a. Legal dependents of Full-time Mecklenburg County Employees. Students (NC/SC, Public/Private school, etc.) in Kindergarten through 5th Grade are eligible to participate.
2. Will meals be provided?
 - a. Breakfast and Lunches will be provided. We ask that the participant bring an afternoon snack and water bottle.
3. Will masks be required?
 - a. Yes, masks will be required for all staff and participants. We will be taking outside Mask Breaks during the day.
4. What will I need to bring?
 - a. You will need to bring everything your child will need to complete their academic work, including school assigned electronic devices and headphones.
5. What if my child needs to take medication?
 - a. Parents will receive information on medication administration in the parent packet. If you have any questions, please call 980-314-1045.
6. What time will the program be offered?
 - a. Drop off: 7:30 to 9 am. We ask that your child be dropped off 30 minutes prior to their first class.
 - b. Pick Up: 4pm to 5:30 pm.
7. What types of Enrichment Activities will be offered?
 - a. Fitness, Environmental Education and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) activities.
8. Who will be supervising the program?
 - a. All staff will be Mecklenburg County Park and Recreation Employees. All staff have completed background checks and are certified in CPR/First Aid.
9. How many children will be in a class?
 - a. We will host a maximum of 10 students per room.
10. What measures will be in place to prevent the spread of germs?
 - a. We will follow all CDC guidelines for keeping children safe. Some of these measures include:
 - i. Upon arrival children will go through a symptom screening checklist and will be scanned with a thermometer.
 - ii. Children will then be dropped off outside and we will limit visitors inside.
 - iii. When entering and exiting the building children will be required to wash hands.
 - iv. Children workspaces will be placed 6 feet apart
 - v. be cleaned and disinfected as often as possible.
 - vi. Use of shared objects (e.g., gym or physical education equipment, art supplies, toys, games) will be cleaned between use.
