Gates open by 18:30 and the game begins at 20:25.</p> <p>WEATHER: See above</p> <p>A Decision Support System (DSS) is in-place with the National Weather Service (NWS). Any severe weather within 15-miles of the stadium the NWS will contact CFD Alarm and the Emergency Management Representative at the MOC with the weather details.</p> <p>SAFETY: Water will be provided at the Mobile Operations Center (MOC) for all personnel working the event. All personnel should wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for the weather and incident specific response.</p> <p>LOCATION CHANGE: The Mobile Operations Center (MOC) has been relocated this season to the corner of West 1st Street and South Mint Street. Access to this intersection MUST be made from South Church Street. All apparatus are to park along the right curb lane along West 1st Street approaching South Mint Street. The order of apparatus along the street will be the following: MOC, Haz-Mat, Tanker followed by CFD staff vehicles. Do not block any access to driveways or parking decks along West 1st Street.
